Your primary purpose in this section is to respond both positively and negatively to the book's content and the author's presentation. This section should be three pages in length. ### Guidelines for Writing a Critical Book Review

In a critical analysis essay, you systematically evaluate a work's effectiveness including what it does well and what it does poorly. It can be used to discuss a book, article or even a film. You must read the piece carefully and may need to look up terms or concepts you are unfamiliar with or research related reading prior to writing your essay.

Structuring the book review. Most book reviews are between 100-500 words, though an academic review may go up to 1500. Check with the lecturer if you are not sure how long your book review should be. At the start, put the complete bibliographic information: Title in full, author, publisher, date of publication edition, number of pages.

A review is a more demanding task that asks you to read a book, think about it and put together a written piece that will tell others whether they should read it, too.
