In some cases, HPRB and HPO also use the nationwide historic preservation standards and guidelines issued by the National Park Service (NPS).

The intent of the guidelines is to provide guidance for development in the Historic District, in order to help preserve the cultural and architectural integrity of the district.

Design Guidelines for Preservation Commissions

These standards apply to each statutorily-identified discipline as it is practiced in historic preservation nationwide. Five disciplines were addressed in 1983 according to the statutory provisions then in place. Amendments to NHPA added more disciplines to be considered, and updates of the original standards need to be accomplished.
